Important new safety measures to keep us all safe - Fuck Covid 19!



Wash your ass, cover your mouth, blah blah blah...

We've all heard it all before, but unfortunately some people still continue to do gross things like pick their ass & not think they have to wash their hands! Instead, they go around touching other objects & PEOPLE & for some fucked up reason they think it's ok... I will never understand why, but all it takes is ONE person to spread their ass germs & any other diseases/viruses. Don't be that asshole! Let's all work together by making smart respectful decisions & by doing our best to remain safe & healthy. **If you hate reading & want to go directly to the rules, they start on page 2 highlighted in yellow.**

Infection Prevention & Control

We want all of our V.I.P. clients to know that at Tattoo JoJo & Studio we have ALWAYS maintained a clean & sterile environment, but now we are taking EXTRA precautions in order to keep everyone & the studio safe. The state of Indiana requires all tattoo artists' to have a Blood Borne Pathogens, which of course we already have. However, Gem Femme & I decided to go the extra mile & get certified for something that isn't required... an IPC certificate. The course was for Infection Prevention & Control for Novel Coronavirus (Covid-19). The course is very informative & teaches you how to respond to a case of an emerging respiratory virus such as the novel coronavirus, how to identify a case once it occurs, and how to properly implement IPC measures to ensure there is no further transmission. The course is intended for healthcare workers & public health professionals BUT everyone is welcome to take it & it's *FREE!* If you're interested in taking that course, I'll leave the link right [HERE](#). I'm sure some of you all will appreciate it. Do something great & feed your brain with knowledge... it could save you or someone else's life!

Don't be a baby & just follow the simple rules!

Our rules really aren't that hard to follow, so we pray that everyone can just act right & follow them. Our intentions aren't to upset anyone, but to make our studio a better, cleaner, & safer environment. We are a new business & things are going to be changing from time to time as we see what works & what doesn't work. Some of these changes we were already planning to make happen before all this coronavirus took place, so a lot of these rules may still apply once everything is lifted. Don't be surprised!

The rules are as follows for clients:

- ❖ Walk-ins of any kind will no longer be allowed. Whether you are getting a tattoo, tooth gem, or just wanna check out new products or merch, you MUST first book an appointment at tattoojojo.com/book-online.
- ❖ EVERYONE is required to do a consultation, *even for tooth gems*. Consultations will now be done online via video chat. After you submit your consultation form online, please email us your preferred method of communication such as facetime, skype, etc. We like to use facetime but understand that not everyone has facetime. You will also need to give us your username or phone #, so we can actually do the video consultation.
- ❖ When you arrive for your appointment, your temperature will be taken. If your temperature is 100.4+ you will be asked to reschedule your appointment & will have to book at least 14 days out. Any client that arrives with symptoms will be asked to reschedule.
- ❖ Please bring a face mask to your appointment. If you don't have one of your own, we will provide you with one, but we are trying to save them for the ones that really need it.
- ❖ After being checked, everyone will need to wash their hands at our wash station for at least 20 seconds.
- ❖ Sanitizer must be used throughout the day.

- ❖ Please come alone to your appointment. If you MUST have someone, you may bring one person with you, but only one person. If you booked an appointment with a group of people & everyone is having a service done, then that will be accepted. We know some of you all like to make memories together... like getting matching tattoos!
- ❖ Please make babysitting arrangements for your children. If you do decide to bring them as your one person support team, then they must be at least 16 years old. Don't worry, for certain events that we have, you may be allowed to bring your kids. We will always let you know in advance. Right now we want to keep the babies safe & this is something we have been thinking about doing before coronavirus. We love kids & have one of our own, but children can be a huge distraction.
- ❖ We have jewelry & products that you may purchase, but clients/customers will not be allowed to handle it.
- ❖ If you are sick, or even feel like you may be getting sick, please call or email us ahead of time so we can reschedule you.
- ❖ Please don't touch your fresh tattoo with your dirty hands & then touch other objects. Don't touch your fresh tattoo period! This is cross contamination & can also lead to infection. Keep your germs to yourself!
- ❖ If you have to use the restroom, take a break, smoke, etc. all tattoos will be plastic wrapped before doing so, to prevent spreading germs or causing infection. This is something I have always done though. Please again, make sure to wash hands & sanitize during your breaks.

Us artists' will even follow the rules & continue to do the following daily:

Deep clean, sanitize, & disinfect all used surfaces such as: countertops, pens, tablets, seating areas, work stations, furniture, display cases, & even furniture. This will be done daily & throughout the day. We will also screen ourselves before coming into work. If we are sick, we will reschedule any appointments we may have had that day. We will also make sure to wash our hands throughout the day & in between clients. No service will be done without a face mask & gloves will always be worn during each service. Again, we will do everything we can to keep YOU & the studio safe.

Thank you all for being awesome & for understanding. If any of our V.I.P. clients need someone to talk to during these hard times, you all are more than welcome to reach out to us. We will be there for you as best as we can.
